

Queensland Heritage Awards 2026

Submission Support Guidelines

To assist the judging panel in fully understanding and assessing each nomination, submissions should be supported by clear, relevant, and well-organised documentation. Entrants are encouraged to provide material that demonstrates the scope, significance, and outcomes of the project, as well as the approach taken to conserving and celebrating Queensland's heritage.

Where relevant, we recommend that submissions include the following supporting information:

- A written summary of the project or works undertaken, including key contributors and stakeholders involved.
- Documentation that clearly illustrates the project, such as drawings, reports, publications, photographs, videos, or other visual material.
- Conservation documentation referenced or relied upon as part of the project, including Conservation Management Plans, Heritage Impact Statements, or similar.
- Reviews or evaluations that may have been prepared following the project's completion.
- Any additional material that assists the judges in gaining a comprehensive understanding of the project.
